NATIONAL CAPITAL CONSORTIUM OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES (MOONLIGHTING) POLICY

ACGME Institution Requirements: IV.K.1 and IV.K.1.a-d

Professional Activities outside of GME Training/Moonlighting: Trainees are not allowed to engage in outside activities that interfere with their education, performance, or clinical responsibility, compensated or not. This includes off-duty medical employment, often referred to as “moonlighting.” Trainees found to engage in such activities will be subject to disciplinary actions to include adverse academic action. Policies prohibiting outside activities are also contained in the Service Branch-specific GME training contract, service specific instructions and NCC Training Agreement. If a trainee has questions regarding participation in an outside activity they should seek guidance from their program director prior to initiation of that activity.
