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## **NATIONAL CAPITAL CONSORTIUM MOONLIGHTING POLICY**

ACGME Institution Requirements: IV.K.1 and IV.K.1.a-d

Professional Activities outside Residency/Moonlighting: Trainees are not allowed to engage in activities that interfere with education, performance, or clinical responsibility. Trainees are not allowed to moonlight. Attendance at outside activities must be approved by the Department Head of the Service of which he/she is currently assigned, and by the Program Director. Written records of approval for attendance at outside activities must be maintained by the Program Director.

Policies prohibiting moonlighting are also contained in both the Service Branch-specific GME training contract and NCC Training Agreement.
